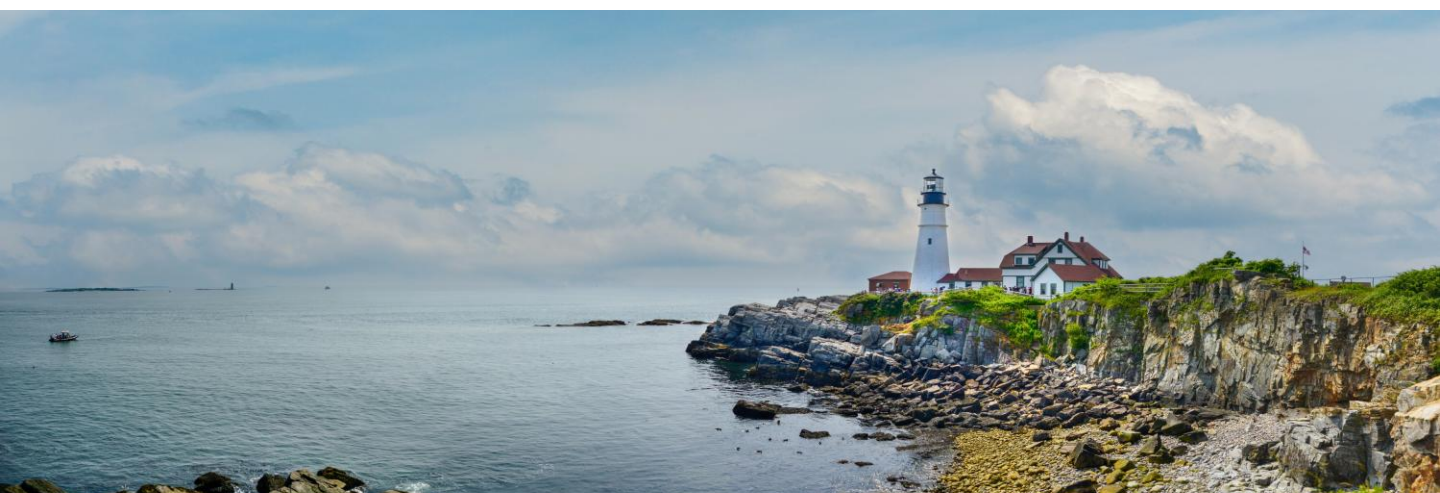

NERGC is excited to be back in Portland, ME, after 22 years! NERGC 2027 will be at the Holiday Inn By The Bay, 88 Spring Street, Portland, ME.

NERGC 2027 has arranged for a block of rooms, spanning Tuesday, April 13 through Sunday, April 18, the conference rate is available for three days before and after the conference as well. Rooms include complimentary wireless internet.

We have a selection of different size rooms depending on your needs with the designated costs below.

- 2 Queen = \$159/night
- Standard King = \$159/night
- Executive King = \$184/night
- Presidential Suite (2 BR) = \$395/night

The above pricing is before taxes, currently Maine State Lodging Tax is 9%, and Local Assessment is currently at 1.5%.

Hotel Check-In is 3 p.m. Hotel Check-Out is 11 a.m. Room availability cannot be guaranteed for early check-in, but they do have luggage storage available.

Discounted Parking for Hotel Guests will be \$15 per vehicle per night, this will be added to your hotel bill, you will have unlimited in and out privileges. Day Guests who park in the external garage next to the hotel will be \$10 (CASH ONLY, no Credit Card) per vehicle, per day with one in and out.

The hotel reservation deadline is March 13, 2027. We will explore options at other hotels as our block of rooms fills up.

FROM THE HOSPITALITY COMMITTEE

Chocolate lovers are in for a treat. Portland and the surrounding area offer several great spots to satisfy your sweet tooth.



Chocolats Passion is our first stop and it's the closest. They are located at 175 Spring Street, Suite D. As you come out of the main entrance of the Holiday Inn By The Bay and face Spring Street, turn left and walk 0.3 miles (about 7 minutes).

They have a wide assortment including bars, cremes, caramels, and boxes. Those of you who are vegan will appreciate their selection of bars, cremes and fruit-based items.

Old Port Candy Co. is a ten-minute walk east of the hotel at 422 Fore Street in the Old Port.

They carry fudge, chocolate bark, caramels, and turtles along with nostalgic favorites like Charleston Chew, Chuckles, and Smarties.

If you have a nut allergy, they offer several nut-free options, including a Reese's-style cup made with sunflower butter. Their website is <https://www.oldportcandy.com/>.

Dean's Sweets has two locations in Portland. One is at 475 Fore Street and the other at 54 Cove Street. Both locations are a short drive or a longer walk from the hotel. Co-owners Kristin and Dean Bingham pride themselves on using as many local ingredients as possible.

You'll find over 30 varieties of truffles, caramels, and buttercreams along with seasonal products. According to their website, they don't use any nuts or nut products, and all the chocolates are gluten-free. They also have dairy-free and vegan chocolates as well. Len Libby has a vast assortment of chocolates, nuts, taffy, and confections. They include items made with real Maine maple syrup and Maine blueberries.

In addition to the chocolate, there's a bonus you won't want to miss—Lenny the Moose:



Lenny is made of 1,700 pounds of milk chocolate. He was carved on-site over the span of four weeks and made his first appearance back in 1997.
